Catholic Education Week 2024



- The theme for Catholic Education Week 2024 is *Pilgrims of Hope*.
- In Scotland, we observe Catholic Education Week from the Feast of St Margaret of Scotland, 16th November - the Feast of St Andrew, 30th November.
- Catholic schools in Scotland are invited to participate in a national prayer supper on Friday 29th November to celebrate St Andrew, *'Protector of Scots'*.
- The Novena to St Andrew is available in a separate document. Schools are invited to participate daily from 20th November.
- Speaker notes are available in a separate document for Mass or assemblies.

During this time in particular, schools are encouraged to celebrate Catholic Education with their families and faith communities.

Clergy/religious orders where possible, should be invited to participate, however young people are encouraged to be leaders of their faith and therefore should feature prominently in the worship and celebration, whether primary or secondary, or as a joint campus celebration.

Schools are encouraged to open their doors to their communities; as an act of charity, and to showcase their Faith Professed, Faith Celebrated, Faith Lived and Faith Prayed. This is an opportunity to demonstrate Church teaching from across all 8 curricular areas in the context of Scottish Education.

Schools are encouraged to 'break bread' with parents and carers; to reconnect with the primary caregivers whose support is relied upon in our schools, as well as in their parishes.
