Subject: Depute Head Leadership Conference: The Good Shepherd Pathway

Dear colleagues,

You will have seen in our newsletter details of the new initiative to support leadership within Catholic schools.

The Good Shepherd Pathway is being developed to offer learning, activities and experiences for teachers within Catholic schools that allow them to explore the vocational and relational dimension of leading a community of faith.

I am delighted that we are able to offer a conference for depute head teachers, as our first CLPL event in the Good Shepherd Pathway. This is being organised in partnership with Redemptorist Press and offers a full programme of input and accompaniment for staff. It will be hosted from 5.30pm on the 16th April until 4pm on the 18th April in St. Mary's Monastery, Kinnoul, Perth. The cost of the conference is £350 and includes Conference Fees, Resources, Full board accommodation in single, en-suite rooms in the Monastery. I have attached a draft of the conference timetable – please note that some details and timings may change.

The conference is open to primary and secondary school depute head teachers who are considering the move to headship within the next 2 years.
